

Rules and Regulations

- M.C.Q. type questions, having one correct answer, for standard IX will be there from the prescribed syllabus in this brochure. Total 120 questions will be there where 3 marks will be awarded for one right answer, minus one for one wrong answer and zero for no answer.
- Two hours will be the total duration of the exam.
- There will be three groups in the entire question paper. First group will consist of language, i.e. Bengali and English or Hindi and English. Second group i.e. General Science which will consist of Physics, Chemistry, Life Science and Mathematics. Last group i.e. social studies will consist of History and Geography.
- In the answer paper, for each question you will get four circles / bubbles. Four circle/ bubbles represent four options. You will have to fill in the bubble containing the correct answer with black ink or blue ink.
- It will be treated as wrong answer if someone fills in more than one bubble for one particular question.
- The bubble must be carefully filled in without spillage marks outside it.
- Only blue / black ball point pen must be used on the answer paper.
- Question paper will be set in Bengali & English.
- Except Pen, Pencil, Geometry Box, Water Bottle, Admit Card, nothing else will be allowed inside the Examination Centre.
- Without Admit Card no one will be allowed inside the centre.
- Parents will not be allowed inside the venue premises.
- Date & Venue: 15th December, Sunday, 2024,12 noon to 2.00 pm;
 List of venues has been given later separately.
- Please report half an hour before scheduled exam time.
- Fees: A sum of rupees one hundred and fifty (Rs. 150) for the examination fees.
- Concessions: Considering the overall condition of a student, Head of The Institution may send ten students with a concession fees of rupees fifty for each student, along with a forwarding letter, and also five students with full concession.

Each year nearly 1.2 million people die and millions of other are injured or disabled as a result of road traffic crashes. The vast majority (over 90%) of all road traffic deaths and injuries occur in low-income and middle-income countries.
